## Waldo County General Hospital: Then and Now

Waldo County General Hospital, located in Belfast, Maine, has been serving the healthcare needs of Waldo County residents and visitors since 1901. Belfast has a long history as a Maine seaport town with boat building, fishing and tourism as its primary industries. Today, the hospital and its 5 rural health centers service more than 64,000 outpatient visits each year.

In Q2 of 2008, the Imaging Department at WCGH upgraded the hospital's PACS and administrative systems to Infinitt's single database RIS/PACS. -  Development and deployment of a feature-rich Mammography Management module that simplifies patient letter production and drives

productive and accurate record keeping.
