

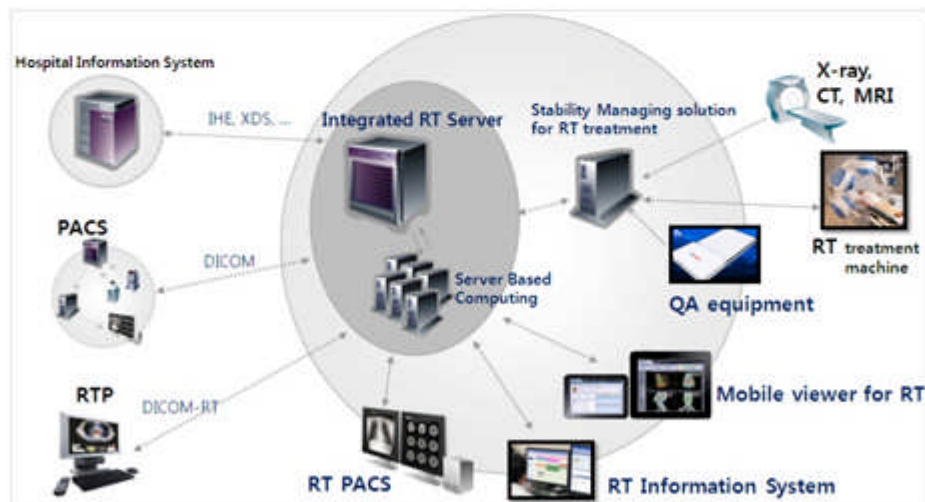

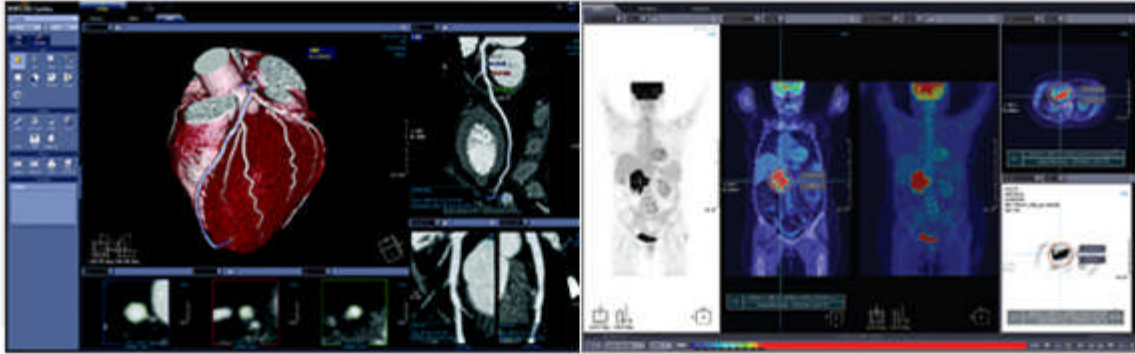
INFINITT Healthcare to Develop the World's First 'Integrated Radiation Therapy Management System'

Hanoi-American International Hospital (Vietnam) to Implement INFINITT RIS & PACS

INFINITT Vietnam signed a contract for INFINITT RIS & PACS with Hanoi-American International Hospital on September 14, 2011.
